Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Sixth Form 5 day, 4 night, Trip to Greece – Friday 25 to Tuesday 29 October 2019

Following our successful visit to Iceland in 2018, I am pleased to be able to offer students the opportunity to take a trip to Greece in the October half-term break in 2019. The visit will be a hugely exciting opportunity to experience the wonders that Greece has to offer and will include a comprehensive tour of the archaeological sites of the Eastern Peloponnese where students will visit the classical Greek ruins at Mycenae and Epidaurus. They will also travel north to the fascinating site at Delphi. In Athens, they will visit the principal sites at the Acropolis and Agora as well as spending time at the National Archaeological museum. The trip includes a city tour and a visit to the lively Plaka district and Monastiraki flea market.

The anticipated cost of the trip will be £750 to include:

- Return flights from UK airport with EasyJet. (cabin baggage)
- Accommodation in 3 star hotels based on twin rooms with ensuite.
- Breakfast and dinner at hotel (starting with dinner on day 1 and ending with breakfast on day 5).
- Professional English speaking guide throughout our stay in Greece.
- Transportation by Private Coach during our stay and for UK transfers.
- Admission fees and tours detailed in final itinerary.
- 100% financial protection through Kipling Tours Travel Trust Association License and ATOL License.

We would require a non-refundable initial deposit of £225 by the 30 March 2019 to secure a place on the trip and enable the tour company to get the best deal available for the flights. A second deposit of £150 will be required by the 2 May to secure the accommodation. The rest of the cost can be paid in instalments, which will be set out once we have confirmed numbers for the trip. Please also complete the slip below with the student's full name as it appears on their passport as well as their current age and DOB. The final payment will be due on or before the 8 September 2019.

In order to keep school administration costs to a minimum we will no longer be able to process any cash or cheque payments to the school. All payments must be made via ParentPay. This is done online via www.parentpay.com or via PayPoint at local stores where you will see the PayPoint logo (see school website or school office for a list of stores). If you wish to use this method, you will need to contact school to obtain a barcoded letter. Please contact the finance office if you require confirmation of your login details or any further support.
