Rewards



The school will reward students who:

- work hard in lessons and at home
- make good progress in their work
- continually show high standards of behaviour, good manners, courtesy and common sense in lessons and around school
- perform exceptional acts of service to others, to the form, School or community
- maintain very high attendance.

R1: First Reward

Verbal praise, work stamped or positive written comment.

R2: Second Reward

Credits for Year 7 and Year 8 students. Certificates will be awarded weekly by the Head of Year.

Reward Cards for Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11 students. Student's hand them in to the Head of Year for entry into a prize draw (six per year).

Credits and Reward Cards may be given for:

- praiseworthy effort or behaviour
- attending extra-curricular activities, eg sports/music practices or clubs
- excellent work
- other positive contributions to the school or wider community

R3: Third Reward

Postcard sent home by individual teaching staff, personal tutor or Head of Year. These may be given for:

- exceptional hard work or effort
- an exceptional piece of work
- achieving targets set
- exceptional contributions to the School or wider community

R4: Fourth Reward

Letter sent home to congratulate student for:

- consistently high standard of work
- significant effort or progress
- positive contribution to the School or community over a prolonged period.

R5: Fifth Reward

Students will be given individual verbal praise by the Headteacher, a 'High Achiever' Award and a personalised letter will be sent home. These may be given in recognition of outstanding contributions to school life.
