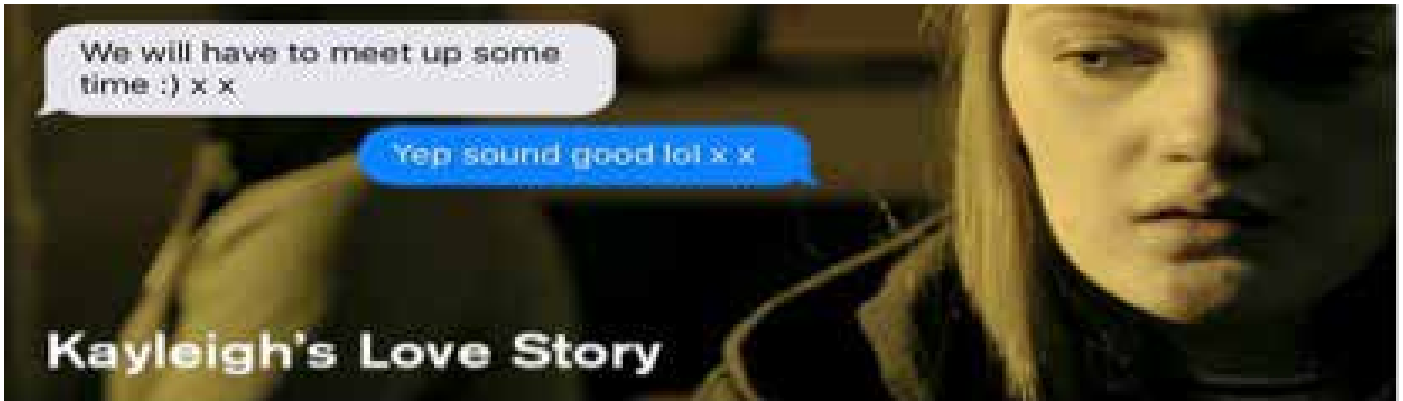


Working with Young People to promote online safety

Kayleigh's Love Story



Kayleigh Haywood began speaking to Luke Harlow, a man she had never met, on 31 October 2015. Over the course of 13 days they exchanged 2643 messages.

In the early hours of Sunday 15 November, having been held against her will, Kayleigh was raped and murdered.
