Information for all students

There is no study leave. If you do not have an exam then you must attend lessons as normal.

Examinations follow the basic pattern of the normal school day.

- **AM Session** - starts at 8:50 AM
- Students should assemble in the coffee bar area **15 minutes** before the start time. Do not go to registration if you have a morning exam.
- **PM Session** – starts at either 1:20 PM or 1:40 PM depending on the length of the exam. You may wish to bring a packed lunch with you as lunchtime will be shorter.
- Students should assemble in the coffee bar area **15 minutes** before the start time.

On leaving an exam you must go straight back to your normal lesson unless told otherwise.

Please note that there are no mock exams for the following subjects: Creative iMedia, Drama, Engineering, BTEC Sport.

Please put all your belongings in a locker before you assemble for an exam. Mobile phones, any kind of smartwatch, ordinary wristwatch, or other electronic equipment **must not** be taken into the examination hall. Coats, bags, jackets, scarves and food are not allowed in the examination hall.

Water can be taken into the examination hall, but **only** in a clear bottle without a label.

Clashes – if you have a clash with two exams timetabled at the same time, e.g. you do both French and German, we will contact you separately providing you with information on when you will sit each exam.

Absence - if you are absent for one or more exams we will arrange for the exam(s) to be taken at another time. Please inform school of your absence as soon as possible, in the usual way.

Equipment - please make sure you have the right equipment for each exam in a clear bag or pencil case. You must use **black ink**. Remember that extra equipment such as a pencil, ruler and/or calculator may be needed in certain subjects e.g. Maths, Science, Geography and D&T exams. Please check with your subject teachers. Spare equipment will not be lent out for hygiene reasons.
